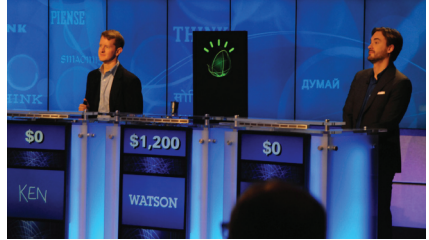

## Watch IBM's Watson compete on *Jeopardy!*

**Tuesday, February 15, 2011**  
**7:00-8:15 pm, EE105**

Artificial Intelligence is the science of making computers that can achieve human-level intelligence and more. In 1997, an IBM AI system named Deep Blue defeated the human world champion in a chess match. But the game of *Jeopardy!* — which requires 3-second responses and the understanding of English questions, puns, and a massive knowledge base of facts — is a much harder challenge. On February 15<sup>th</sup>, an IBM AI system named Watson will be pitted against two human champions. We will broadcast this event live in EE105.

Professors from UW Computer Science & Engineering and experts from IBM and Microsoft will be on hand to provide commentary.
